

Nanaimo Airport COVID-19 Visitor Self-Assessment

To ensure a healthy and hygienic environment, we ask that all visitors complete this self-assessment prior to entering Nanaimo Airport buildings and facilities.

Screening Questions	YES	NO
1. Have you travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days?		
2. Has a member of your household returned from outside of Canada within the last 14 days?		
3. Have you been in contact with someone who has travelled outside of Canada and who is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 (cough, fever, difficulty breathing)?		

If you answered yes to question 1, 2, or 3, you are prohibited from entering any Nanaimo Airport building or facility for 14 days. The 14 days will begin from the day that you returned to Canada or the first day of no longer having contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19.

Screening Questions	YES	NO
4. Do you have a fever with or without cough or congestion?		
5. Do you have any signs or symptoms of respiratory or flu-like illness or have had signs or symptoms of COVID -19 in the past 14 days?		

If you answered yes to question 4 or 5, you are prohibited from entering any Nanaimo Airport building or facility. You may return to the site after a 14-day period and when you have been symptom free for at least 72 hours and cleared by your doctor to return to work or normal activities.

If you answered no to all questions, please complete and sign this assessment, and give to Nanaimo Airport personnel on arrival.
